#### Tournament Regulations

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a player member to Table Tennis England or be a member of another national association in membership of the ITTF.
2. Table Tennis England Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament.
3. All competitors will be required to umpire matches and knockout matches at the discretion of the Referee.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games to eleven points unless both players score ten points, when the game shall be won by the player first gaining a lead of two points. Play throughout will be on a knockout basis with the exception of preliminary rounds, which may, at the discretion of the Referee, be on a group basis. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
5. Competitors in the Junior events must have been born in 1998, the Cadets 2001 or later, Under 13s 2003 or later and the Under 11s 2005 or later.
6. Competitors must wear rubber-soled shoes, and clothing which complies with ITTF Regulations 3.02.02.01 –3.0.02.07. Players must not wear shirts that are predominantly white.
7. Competitors will be permitted to practise on tables not in use, at the discretion of the Referee.
8. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
9. All competitors must report to the control desk on arrival and must not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players who are absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
10. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
11. The use of rackets prepared with glue containing VOCs will not be allowed.
12. The Referee's decision will be final on points of law, and any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on questions of fact by an umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final.
13. Every player must hold a valid Table Tennis England Player Licence or have paid the appropriate Single Competition Licence fee with his/her entry form unless he/she provides proof of being a member of another national association affiliated to the ITTF.
14. The Organising Committee hold the right to change the schedule if required by number of entries.

**10:00 Under 11s and Cadet groups**

**14:00 Under 13s and Junior groups**

**12:00 Under 11s and Cadet Knockout rounds and Plate**

**16:00 Under 13s and Junior Knockout rounds and Plate**

#### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. Entry form— all entries must be sent to the tournament referee by the closing date of 15 January 2016
2. Entries— Entry forms shall be submitted with full payment of fees
3. Playing conditions— play throughout will be on 9 Joola 2000-SC tables, nets and posts with Xushaofa 3 star white poly-balls. Individual court size 9m x 5m minimum enclosed by surrounds. Scoring machines will be used for all matches.
4. Refreshments— are available at the venue.
5. Changing—facilities are available.
6. Entries— if it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on last received, first out basis. These events are often oversubscribed, so enter early to avoid disappointment.
7. Practice— there will be no separate practice facilities. Competitors will be permitted to practise on tables not in use, at the discretion of the Referee.
8. Entry fee refunds will only be issued at the discretion of the Referee and Blitz TTC. Claims to have any entry fees refunded must be received within seven days of the conclusion of the event.
9. Car parking is available at the venue.
10. Winners and runners-up of all events, including Plate events, will receive a trophy.
11. The draw will be displayed on the club website [www.blitz.co.uk](http://www.blitz.co.uk) and/or Facebook page one week before the event.
