CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

1. The Championships will be conducted under the present laws of the game and in accordance with the rules and regulations of E. T. T. A.
2. All Matches to be on knock-out principle, or group basis according to entries.
- 3a. Players in Junior events 1 and 2 must have been born after 30th June, 1966, and for all other events 30th June, 1963.
- 3b. Players in Senior events No. 1 must have been born after 30th June, 1959 and in the event No. 7 must have been 40 or over on 30th June, 1980.
4. No entries will be accepted after the closing date and no alterations to the draw will be made after the commencement of any event.
5. If it is necessary to restrict entries, it will be on the basis of "last received" — "first out."
6. All competitors must report to Central Control. All players must be prepared to play as and when required on any table. Players absent when called upon to play will be scratched.
7. All players must be correctly dressed.
8. No competitor will be compelled to umpire but it is hoped that players will assist in this respect.
9. In the event of any question arising not provided for in these regulations, the decision of the Championship Referee will be final.
10. All competitors must have made at least one league appearance before submitting entry forms.
11. Any event attracting less than 8 entrants may be cancelled by the Committee.

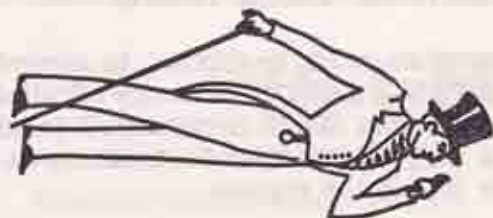

RULES

1. **TITLE:** The league shall be called the Grantham & District Table Tennis League.
2. **OBJECTS:** The objects of the league shall be to conduct competitions between affiliated clubs, to arrange and conduct such other competitions as are deemed desirable, to assist and encourage the formation of Table Tennis Clubs in Grantham and District and to further the interests of the game in every way.
3. **EXTENT:** The area of Administration of the Grantham & District Table Tennis League shall be within the area covered by a circle of 15 miles radius with Grantham Market Place as its centre. Should it be found that at any time this area of Administration conflicts with the area of any other League or Body, such matter shall be referred to arbitration between the Executive Committees of the organisations concerned.
4. **ADMINISTRATION:**
 - (a) The League shall appoint the following officers:— President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Match Secretary, Inter-Town Secretary, Coaching Secretary and Umpiring Secretary.
 - (b) The number of Honorary Auditors appointed shall be determined by the Executive Committee, who shall not be Officers of the League.
 - (c) All the Officers and Committee shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting of the League.
Nominations of names of officers and general committee for the following season shall be proposed and seconded and in the hands of the secretary, in writing, no less than seven days prior to the A.G.M. Nominations can also be accepted at the A.G.M. prior to the vote.
 - (d) The management of the League affairs shall be vested in an Executive Committee together with eight representatives from the League.

- (e) The Executive Committee shall have the power to co-opt two other members from affiliated clubs and to appoint sub-committees.
 - (f) The Executive Committee shall have the power to fill vacancies in the Officers of the League should they occur during the season. They shall also be empowered to appoint any other Official should it be considered appropriate but appointments so made shall only be held until the next Annual General Meeting.
 - (g) The Hon. Treasurer shall be responsible for all monies belonging to the League from whatsoever source derived and shall bank all such monies in the name of 'The Grantham & District Table Tennis League.'
 - (h) All cheques for the withdrawal of monies from the Bank shall be signed by the Chairman, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, or any two of the above named.
 - (i) The working year for the League affairs and finance shall be from 1st June to 31st May.
 - (j) Rule cancelled AGM July 1973.
 - (k) Any Committee member failing to attend two consecutive meetings without any apology may be automatically replaced by co-option of the standing committee.
5. **MEETINGS:**
 - (a) The Annual General Meeting shall be held not later than 7th July, in each year.
 - (b) At least seven clear days notice shall be given of each General or Special Meeting of the League.
 - (c) A Special General Meeting may be convened by the Executive Committee or by a request signed by not less than four Affiliated Clubs and forwarded to the Hon. Secretary.
 - (d) The Executive Committee shall meet as deemed necessary.
 - (e) The quorum at any Executive Committee shall be five.
 6. A copy of audited statement of accounts and notice of all resolutions received shall be sent to each member club at least seven days before the A.G.M.

7. COMPOSITION OF THE LEAGUE:

- (a) The League shall be composed of as many divisions as determined by the Executive Committee.
- (b) At the end of each season the two leading teams in each division, other than the Premier Division, shall be promoted to the next higher Division, and the two bottom teams in each Division other than the lowest Division, shall be relegated to the next lower Division. The Executive Committee shall have the power to fill any vacancies in any Division.
- (c) Should a team withdraw or be expelled from the League during the Season, then the results of such matches shall be deleted from the League Tables. A new team shall be one that consists of 2/3 unknown players. All new teams will be placed in the lowest senior or junior division. All divisions of the League shall consist of a maximum of 12 and a minimum of 8 teams.
- (d) The positions in the League shall be determined on the basis of:
Win : 2 points.
Draw : 1 point.
Loss : 0 points.
- (e) In the event of a tie on points for the position in the League Tables, the placing shall be determined by the rubbers difference. Where there are two or more teams in a league table at the end of the season with the same number of points and where match cancellations resulting in the loss of rubbers are found not to be the fault of the teams in question and would have affected the positions of the said teams for promotion or relegation a play-off be staged.
- (f) All matches must be played in accordance with the fixture list as issued, unless by mutual agreement between both Captains and the Match Secretary. Any change in venue or home night, after the handbook has been printed, must be notified in writing, by the Secretary of the club concerned to all the teams in the relevant division. Failure to do this will result in the loss of the points for the match against any club not so informed.

- (g) All matches must commence not later than 7.30 p.m. other than by mutual agreement between the team captains. Matches played in Educational Premises to commence at 7 p.m. except Stoke College Juniors 6.30 p.m. Two players must be ready to start at time stated.
- (h) Results of all matches played under the auspices of the League shall be recorded on the official prescribed form by the Home and Away teams. These cards shall be received by the Match Secretary bearing a postmark not later than the Saturday following the match. Cards delivered by hand shall reach the Match Secretary not later than the Monday following the match. Failure to do this will result in the offending team losing both points and rubbers gained in that match. In the case of forfeit matches only points will be awarded.
- (i) All protests and disputes shall be forwarded to the League Secretary for consideration at the next Executive Committee Meeting.

8. AFFILIATION:

- (a) All clubs as prescribed in Rule 3 shall be eligible for membership to the League.
- (b) The Executive Committee reserve the right to refuse the entry of any Club into the League, and shall be empowered to suspend any Club, Team or person for non-observance of the Rules of the League, or for any other misdemeanour.
- (c) Application for League membership for existing clubs must be made in person at the AGM. Clubs will only be allowed to register more than one team if two or more representatives attend the AGM. New clubs will be accepted up to the last day of July. Players names must be submitted with team registration.
- (d) The Affiliation Fees for the Grantham League for each Club and/or Team accepted into the League, shall be the amount as determined at the Annual General Meeting.
- (e) Individual affiliation on the part of interested players or helpers may be allowed at the discretion of the League Management Committee.

9. COMPOSITION OF TEAMS:

- (a) Each team shall be composed of three players, each player playing one set of three games against each member of the opposing team. A set shall be won by the player winning two games of the set.
- (b) Before the commencement of each match the respective Captains shall insert their teams order of play on the Official Result Form. The 'Home' team Captain shall insert his order of play first.
- (c) That teams which do not turn up for their match fixture and do not notify the opposing team captain and the Match Secretary shall be fined £2 for a senior team and £1 for a junior. Teams failing to do so twice during one season will be expelled from the Grantham and District Table Tennis League for that current season.
- (d) That a team reserve registered player can take part in the Doubles event of a league match.

10. REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS:

- (a) The Executive Committee reserve the right to refuse any registration.
- (b) No player can be registered for more than one Club in the League.
- (c) The registration fee for each player shall be an amount determined annually at the Annual General Meeting.
- (d) For each team entered in the League Competition at least three players shall be registered specifically for that team with the Match Secretary.
- (e) In the event of a Club having more than one team competing in the same Division of the League at any one time, each team of the particular Club so concerned shall for the purpose of registration of players be considered as a separate entry, and no transference of players between such teams shall be allowed.

- (f) No player shall be allowed to play in a lower Division of the League than that for which he or she has once played, only at the discretion of the Executive Committee, but may be allowed to play for a team of the Club for which he or she is registered competing in a higher Division, but he or she shall only be permitted to assist one team of the same Club in a higher Division in accordance with the provisions of Rule 10, paragraph (g). No senior Division player may play in a Junior Division.
- (g) If a player has played twice for a team in a higher Division than that for which he was registered, he shall on the third appearance for the team in the higher Division become automatically registered for that team, and shall not be allowed to take part in any further matches played by the team in the lower Division, except as provided for in Rule 10 paragraph (f).
- (h) The penalty of playing an ineligible player shall be the forfeiture of all rubbers won by the ineligible player.
- (i) Transference of players shall be allowed only to a team in the same or higher division.
- (j) That there shall be no registration of players after 1st January in each season except at the discretion of the Executive Committee.
- (k) That the definition of a Junior shall be according to the E.T.T.A. The qualification for all official junior competitions is:—
If a player is under 17 on 1st July in any year, he is eligible for junior events for the whole of the next season, i.e. until 30th June following his 17th birthday.
Intermediate: Under 21 years of age on the 1st July in the preceding year.
Veteran: 40th birthday on or before the 30th June in the preceding year.

11. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

- (a) Motions affecting the Constitution or the Rules of the Grantham & District Table Tennis League may be proposed only by the Executive Committee, accredited representatives of Teams, or Clubs, or by members of

the League affiliated during the previous season. Such motions may be subject to Block Voting as provided in Rule (see below).

- (b) On a motion specified by the above rule the Chairman shall accept a demand for a Block Vote from any accredited club representative or he may decide himself to proceed to a Block Vote. In the absence of demands for a Block Vote, if the Chairman is satisfied that a show of hands indicates a clear decision he may dispense with the Block Vote and declare the decision on the basis of the hands shown.
(Block Vote — In a Block Vote each accredited representative shall exercise one vote for each registered team in his club).
- (c) A majority in excess of opposition of one-third of the votes cast shall be necessary to carry any resolution in respect of the rules of the League. Other resolutions shall be decided by a simple majority vote and in the event of a tie except on financial questions the meeting shall proceed to the next business. In the matter of finance the Chairman shall have the casting vote.
- (d) No person attending the AGM may vote unless he or she is affiliated to the Grantham & District Table Tennis League either through a Club or individually during the season preceding the AGM.

12. GENERAL:

- (a) The Rules of the game as laid down by the English Table Tennis Association shall apply to this League.
- (b) All holders of Trophies which are the property of the League, shall be responsible for their safe custody, and shall be liable for the cost of replacement or making good any damage sustained by the Trophy whilst in their possession. They shall also be required to keep such Trophies in a clean condition.
- (c) Trophies shall normally be held for a period of one year, but they shall be liable for recall at any time as directed by the Executive Committee.
- (d) Any matter not provided for in these Rules shall be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision thereon shall be final.

- (e) Any doubtful interpretation of these Rules shall be referred to the Executive Committee, whose decision shall be final.
- (f) (i) The rules of the League shall not be altered nor added to except at an Annual General Meeting or a special General Meeting convened for the purpose.
(ii) Any amendments or additions to these rules must be in the hands of the secretary 28 days prior to the AGM.
- (g) Any use of unbecoming language and unsportsmanlike conduct by a registered member of the League at any league function to be reported to the committee in order that disciplinary action may be taken.
- (h) The individual award shall be presented to the person who has the most rubbers at the end of the season, within their division. In the event of a tie on rubbers the award will be shared.
